



MEETING NOTES FROM JANUARY 27, 2012

Tracy Raska called The Sharecropper's Meeting to order at 7:12 PM on Friday, January 27, 2012. It was held at the Shelby Volunteer Fire Department Hall meeting room. New members and visitors were welcomed. There were 74 who signed the attendance sheet. Two new members were announced, Brad

Voelkel & family and Charlie Cendalski. Everyone enjoyed the turkey stew and special thanks given to the preparers Edwin Kuehn and crew. Secretary minutes & treasurers report were read & approved.

Old Business: The 2012 club officers were introduced and a list with contact information was provided for anyone needing to reach any of the officers. Tracy asked for any comments on the Christmas party. Several members said they liked the new location because there was more room and that it was well liked. Two lists of the upcoming shows and events were provided by Vice-President/Safety Officer, Dustin Gross.

Club Membership fees were reviewed and Allen Neumann motioned to leave the dues as they are currently (Single person club membership at \$15/year, Family club membership at \$25/year, and EDGETA membership at \$10/year). Royce Bartels seconded this motion and the motion passed.

The 2012 funding limits for the Youth Tractor Restoration Program were discussed. Rodney Sprenger suggested decreasing the program limit a few hundred dollars and decreasing the individual award to \$200 from the current \$250. Donna Townsend motioned to keep the limits at \$250 per individual, not to exceed the \$1,000 limit for the club's program. The individual must be a member of the club through a family membership. It was defined that a family membership, according to club guidelines, included parents and any children under 18 years of age. Allen Neumann seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Tracy & Roger noted that the audit of the books had been completed thanks to Mary Ann Hueske & Corky Marshall and that everything was in order. Rodney Sprenger motioned to dismiss the audit committee & Justin Sommerfeld seconded, and the motion passed.

New Business: Tracy discussed the need to nominate three directors at-large since the club had become 501c3 incorportated. The past president and current president would fill the additional two seats. Rodney Sprenger motioned to nominated Frank Tyson for the first seat with a one year term and Donna Townsend seconded the motion and it passed. Rodney Sprenger motioned to nominated Emery Schultz for the second seat with a two year term and Hilton Thompson seconded the motion and it passed. Bobby Neumann motioned to nominated himself for the third seat with a three year term and Donna Townsend seconded the motion and it passed.

The 2012 youth tractor restoration took nominations from the floor. Candidates included Ryan Guerrero, Cory Schovajsa, and Dustin Bercaulter. Ryan was the only candidate present and discussed the project that all three boys were working on. There was some additional discussion if the candidates were actually able to participate depending on family membership status. Elizabeth and Tracy said they would check into the candidates status. Rodney Sprenger motioned to accept the candidates nominations and provide \$250/candidate based on family status and Brett Studhalter seconded and the motion passed.

A club project day was discussed. It is to be held at Frank Tyson's shed in Brenham. Members are encouraged to bring small projects such as carburetors, etc to work on during the day. Coffee and donuts will be provided and the event is to occur from 9:00am until 2:00pm. It was decided that February 25, 2012 would be a good date for most members who wanted to participate.

Events happening in the next few months were mentioned and referenced to on the preliminary show list handout. A flyer announcing a show in Bastrop on March 2-3, 2012 was provided to all those present.

The Burton Cotton Gin festival was discussed, which will be April 20-21st this year. Ronnie Holt noted that it will be a one day show, but the tractors will be allowed to practice pull Friday night. Rodney Sprenger motioned that a \$10 fee be charged for Friday night pulls and \$15 fee be charged for Saturday pulls. Royce Bartels seconded the motion and it passed.

Tracy noted the provided show lists and special shows including TSC Show & Fundraiser on March 10, 2012. Case/IH Show in conjunction with a sales promotion on March 24, 2012.

The next meeting will be April 13, 2012 at Shelby. Allen Neumann motioned the meeting to be adjourned and Hilton Thompson seconded. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 8:05 PM.

Youth Restoration Program

The Sharecropper's club has set aside \$1,000 this year to help promote youth interested in tractor restoration. To be eligible in this program, a youth must be a member (if 18 years of age, may have individual membership or a family membership under their parents if younger than 18 years of age). 
