Tracy Raska called The Sharecropper's Meeting to order at 6:55 PM on Friday, April 13, 2012. It was held at the Shelby Volunteer Fire Department Hall meeting room. New members and visitors were welcomed. There were 38 who signed the attendance sheet. New members were announced: Ronnie Herzog, Kenneth Hetzel, Kenneth Kana, Gary & June Barnes, Angela Phillips, and Jacob Mikeska.

Secretary, Elizabeth Sommerfeld read the minutes from the January 27, 2012 meeting. Ed Kuehn motioned to accept the minutes as read and Bobby Neumann seconded the motion, and the motion passed. Roger Sorum provided a breakdown of expenses while he gave the Treasurer's report. The most current balance was \$10,053.63. He noted that there were 142 members, 13 new members, 65 who hadn't renewed as of April 9, 2012. Justin Sommerfeld motioned to accept the treasurers report as read and Dan Borghart seconded the motion, and the motion passed.

Old Business: The upcoming Burton Cotton Gin Festival show and pull was discussed. Tracy announced that she had given Roger approval to rent a PA system for \$100 for the weekend as the previously used PA system had broken beyond repair. It was decided that the Friday night meal would be sausage purchased for \$2.25/pound and donated hot dog buns by Country Boy Sausage. The registration table would be run by Roger Sorum, Show and Pull area Chairman and Safety was Dustin Gross, Registration Pull designated to Tracy Raska, Elizabeth Sommerfeld, Nancy Hopper, Leigh Keike, and Kelly Chovanec. The kiddy tractor pull was being organized by Tracy & Bradley Raska with help from Hilton Thompson. The sled and track team was to be headed by Royce Bartels and the engine display headed by Bill Schlobohm. The only donation to be used towards trophies was from Teglar Chevrolet for \$25. Tracy displayed the plaques that were being provided by Burton Cotton Gin. A summary of the Shop Day on February 25, at Frank Tyson's house was given. The TSC show was cancelled due to the rain, but the company had plans to reschedule. The Bastrop 4H and FFA show on March 2-3rd was noted to be well attended as well as the HiWay Equipment (Case) show held on March 24th.

New Business: Erika Guerrero noted that the tractor restored by Ryan Guerrero (who received money from the club through the Youth Restoration Program) had been to the Houston and San Antonio shows. She also mentioned that Blinn Junior College would be having an Ag Day on May 2nd that the tractor would be at as well. She encouraged people to come see all of the displays and stated the event starts at 8:00am. Erika also stated that her family would be providing a scholarship to a Bellville High School senior who was a member of any tractor club on May 15th. The family was deciding whether to award 1-\$500 or 2-\$250 scholarships. Erika also announced that the Keith Bartels scholarship fundraiser tractor ride would be occurring on the 3rd weekend in August.

Events happening in the next few months were mentioned and referenced to on the preliminary show list handout. April 28 in Brenham is the 7th Annual Dan Borchgardt's Tractor Drive, May 12th in Ledbetter is the Harvest & Plow Day, May 27th is the Shelby Volunteer Fire Department Fundraiser and a tractor show is desired. The event will be held at the SVFD hall with a start time around 9:00-9:30am. Sealybration Tractor show will be held on July 14th and applications were provided at the table. On May 9th will be Ag in the Classroom held at the Washington County Fairgrounds. Anyone interested in participating should be there by 8:00am and the event starts at 9:00am for 4th grade students in the Brenham area.

A member brought up the possibility of advertising some of these events in magazines such as Red Power, Antique Power Magazine – Event Catalog, and Texas Highways. Tracy stated this would be a good idea and officers would look into the possibilities of such advertising.

The next meeting will be July 20, 2012 at Shelby. Brett Studhalter motioned the meeting to be adjourned and Emery Schulze seconded. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned at 8:05 PM.
