- If an EDGETA member attends a non-sponsored event and does NOT follow the EDGETA safety requirements, the member will not have coverage.

If a non-member organizes a tractor ride are EDGETA members covered? Yes, if the EDGETA members follow the EDGETA safety requirements for tractor rides.




EVENT HIGHLIGHTS


